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MAHJONG FLAME RETARDANT FABRICS



Games of skill and chance, ancient and modern, Oriental and European lend their names to this collection of flame retardant fabrics for both classic and contemporary interiors.

QUOITS – A wide-width sheer of semi transparent ovals on a contrasting ground.

LOTTO – A semi-plain curtaining fabric with the appearance of a shimmering tweed. May also be used as fabric walling in a suitably prepared environment.

CHARADES – A pattern of mid-scale zigzag rectangles woven with sculpted effect.

SHOGI – A plain velvet of tiny squares in relief.

HOOPLA – A contemporary satin damask trellis of interlocking ovals.

PIQUET – A small-scale textured trellis composed of coloured oblongs.

CHECKERS – A wide-width printed diamond pattern, ideal for curtains and bedspreads.

PINBALL – Small irregular polka dots highlighted in metallic yarn.

FAN-TAN – A jacquard of silky, stylised petals set in rows.
